



## Boren Scholarship Awards

The National Security Education Program's Boren Scholarship provides unique funding opportunities for U.S. undergraduate and graduate students to add important international and language components to their education. These awards focus on geographic areas, languages and fields of study that are critical to U.S. interests and underrepresented in study abroad.

Boren scholars may study in Africa, Asia, Central & Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, or the Middle East.

### AWARD AMOUNTS

Maximum scholarship awards are:

- \$10,000 per semester
- \$20,000 for a full academic year
- \$8,000 for summer

### LENGTH OF STUDY

Boren scholarships promote long term linguistic and cultural immersion, therefore study abroad proposals for 2 or more semesters is strongly encouraged.

Full academic year or semester programs are open to all applicants. Summer awards of 8 weeks or longer are available to students majoring in science, technology, engineering or mathematics.

### LANGUAGE

All proposed programs must include formal study of an appropriate foreign language.
