Position Title: Chair of History and Political Science

Position Type: Full-time

Job Description: The Department of History and Political Science invites applications for a non-tenure track (but tenure eligible) position at the assistant/associate professor level to fill the position of department chair and Associate Professor of Political Science. The department seeks to fill this position in the summer of 2017 but no later than August 2017. The department seeks a dynamic individual to teach core undergraduate courses in History and Political Science. In addition to teaching, the position entails undergraduate student advising; student organization advising, active participation in departmental activities, college and university committees; service learning/internship activities; and active involvement in scholarly activities such as publishing and obtaining grants, student recruiting; working with the dean and other university personnel to implement university policies, work with faculty on curricular and grants or sponsored research projects. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population gained either through cultural study training, teaching or other experiences. Other duties may be assigned for future promotion and tenure consideration and excellence in teaching, research, and service is required.

Requirement/Qualifications: Applicants for this position must hold a terminal degree at the rank of Ph.D. in Political Science. The candidate must have some background in leadership and management. Official copies of college transcripts must be on file by the appointment date for the successful candidate selected. Teaching experience, service, and record of scholarly activity appropriate to the rank is desirable.
