## Virginia Union University Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology MA in Christian Education (MACE) Degree *Two Year Program Pattern of Study*

Students participating in the MACE program will have to complete eighteen (18) courses. These eighteen (18) courses will include eight (8) courses in the basic theological disciplines including Biblical Studies, Church History, Constructive Theology, and Practical Theology. In addition, MACE candidates complete ten (10) courses in education. These courses include Christian Education, Philosophy of Education, Curriculum Theory and Design, Faith and Human Development, Group Dynamics, Music and the Arts in Christian Education, Teaching Practicum, and selected electives.

## **Two Year Program**

(Students will need to take 2 electives during the 2-year period to satisfy the 18 course requirement. Those electives can be taken through the MACE offerings, M.Div. courses or other non-classroom alternatives such as directed studies, independent studies, immersion experiences or special conferences.)
