My overarching goal as president of Virginia Union University is to build and nurture a rewarding, vibrant, and intellectually stimulating university. During the past academic year, we have taken giant steps toward the realization of this goal through the completion of several major initiatives.

The Brighter Future Initiative offers grant incentives to Richmond Public School students with a high school grade point average of 2.2 or better. The Wal-Mart Foundation has joined us in this endeavor, making the dream of a college education an affordable reality to many more of our local high school graduates. During the upcoming year, we will work to expand this program to other localities, as well as solicit the support of other major corporations and foundations.

Virginia Union's amazing story will finally be told in grand style with the opening of a magnificent exhibit in the L. Douglas Wilder Library and Learning Resource Center. Several staff members spent the last academic year researching, writing, and editing the very large panels which chronicle more than 140 years of history. The presentation focuses on the four institutions that merged to form Virginia Union, as well as significant events taking place during the tenure of 11 presidents of the University.

We continue to strengthen our academic program with the addition of a Master of Christian Education in the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology. The School of Theology also received reaffirmation of its accreditation for the next ten years from the Association of Theological Schools. In addition, we are in the process of substantially strengthening library resources for the School of Theology. We are also pleased to announce that the Southern Association of Schools has given the University permission to implement a Continuing and Professional Studies Program, which will help extend our educational offerings to non-traditional populations.

The 2007-08 academic year has been a significant period in the history of Virginia Union University. Your support plays a crucial role in our efforts to sustain the Virginia Union legacy. The future is bright and your continued support is very much appreciated.

# Thousands Celebrate Commencement 2008


Thousands of friends and family members joined the Class of 2008 on Saturday, May 10 as Virginia Union University awarded degrees to 277 related graduates.

Keynote speaker Robert S. Jepson, Jr., chairman and chief executive officer of Jepson Associates, delivered the keynote address. He challenged the graduates to make a difference in their own lives and the lives of others. "If you understand the uniqueness of yourselves, that wonderful power of the human spirit, you can and will make a difference," Jepson said.

Jepson shared seven rules of personal leadership -- the ability to dream, a commitment to excellence, a genuine concern for others, integrity and an uncompromising ethical standard, a willingness to take risks, a tolerance for stress, and a sense of stewardship. "Remember always that your fingerprints on time will be determined by what you give, not by what you take," Jepson added.

Virginia Union University Board of Trustees Chairman Dr.

Frank S. Royal presented the speaker with an honorary degree. Alumnus Wesley Carter also received an honorary degree for his many years of service to Richmond Public Schools and Virginia Union University.



President Belinda C. Anderson recognized graduate Pauline Odessa Thorpe Clarke and her husband Caldwell. "Their story is a true testament to love, love for each other, and love for education," Anderson told the crowd. She explained how the 68-year-old Clarke accompanied his 60-year-old legally blind wife to every class during her four years at Virginia Union. "He took notes for her, he read the textbooks to her, he read the test questions and wrote down her responses," said Anderson.

Clarke says his wife's thirst for knowledge has made him want to pursue a degree, but he may have to wait a few more years. Mrs. Clarke is planning to complete a graduate degree at the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology.

# VUU Announces Brighter Future Initiative



Virginia Union University President Dr. Belinda C. Anderson recently announced the University's new grant program for Richmond Public School students. Richmond Superintendent Dr. Deborah Jewell-Sherman joined Dr. Anderson at a press conference for the announcement of the Brighter Future Initiative. "I am overwhelmed by the magnitude of this gift," said Dr. Jewell-Sherman.

The Brighter Future Initiative provides grant awards of up to \$1400 for 2008 graduates of Richmond public schools who meet the guidelines. It is anticipated that 100 students in the Class of 2008 will receive the awards, which are renewable for another three years.

"I am thrilled that we are able to help Richmond public school students realize their dreams of a college education," said Dr. Anderson. "This is an historic moment in the history of Virginia Union University."

# VUU Dean Elected President of Association Of Theological Schools In United States And Canada



Dr. John W. Kinney, Dean of Virginia Union University's Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology, was recently elected President of the Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada (ATS). ATS is an organization of more than 250 graduate schools with post-baccalaureate professional and academic degree programs designed to educate students for the practice of ministry and for research and teaching in the theological disciplines. The Commission on Accrediting of ATS approves all degree programs offered by the schools.

Dr. Kinney has served Virginia Union's Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology in various leadership capacities since 1978. During his tenure, the Doctor of Ministry Program and the Master of Arts in Christian Education were established. The Master of Divinity Program experienced unparalleled growth, and the Continuing Education program was expanded.

Dr. Kinney received undergraduate and graduate degrees from Marshall University and Virginia Union University's Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology. He received his Ph.D. from Columbia University/Union Theological Seminary in New York. He also serves as pastor of Ebenezer Baptist Church in Beaverdam, Virginia.



## ATS Reaffirms School of Theology Accreditation

The Commission on Accrediting of The Association of Theological Schools (ATS) has reaffirmed the accreditation of the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University. The graduate school was commended for its "sustained energetic leadership" and "attention to spiritual and professional formation facilitated by a close mentoring relationship with faculty, staff, and field supervisors."

The Commission on Accrediting is recognized by the United States Secretary of Education for the accreditation and pre-accreditation of freestanding theological schools, as well as schools affiliated with larger institutions, that offer graduate professional education for ministry and graduate study of theology. Accreditation is governed by standards adopted by the member schools of the Commission.

The reaffirmation of accreditation lasts for a period of 10 years.

## Dr. Anderson Appointed to COMMISSION on COLLEGES

Virginia Union University President Dr. Belinda C. Anderson has been appointed to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) Commission on Colleges. As a Commissioner, Dr. Anderson will be one of a 77-member body elected to represent approximately 790 institutions that are members of the Commission on Colleges.

During her three-year term, Dr. Anderson will assist in determining Commission policy, reviewing and making decisions regarding the accreditation of institutions, and conducting the initial review for proposed modifications to standards of the Commission.

The Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools is the recognized regional accrediting body in the eleven U.S. Southern states (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia) and in Latin America for those institutions of higher education that award associate, baccalaureate, master's or doctoral degrees. The Commission on Colleges is the representative body of the College Delegate Assembly and is charged with carrying out the accreditation process.



## VUU President Elected to CIC Board

The Council of Independent Colleges (CIC) has elected Virginia Union University President Dr. Belinda C. Anderson to its Board of Directors. The elections were held during a meeting of the Board at CIC's 2008 Presidents Institute in Marco Island, Florida on January 4, 2008.

Among the responsibilities of the CIC Directors are providing fiduciary oversight for the allocation of CIC's assets and approving operating budgets, participating in the development and approval of long-range plans, and advising on the direction of the association's programs and services.

"The Council is pleased to have Dr. Anderson as a Board member," said CIC President Richard Ekman. "CIC is in the midst of implementing many exciting new projects, and needs a strong Board of Directors to oversee their planning and execution. I am certain that Dr. Anderson will serve the Council admirably, and the Council looks forward to working with her."

The Council of Independent Colleges is an association of more than 580 independent, liberal arts colleges and universities and higher education affiliates and organizations that work together to strengthen college and university leadership, sustain high-quality education, and enhance private higher education's contributions to society.

# Kay Coles James to Speak at 2008 Convocation



Gloucester Institute President and Founder Kay Coles James will deliver the keynote address at Virginia Union University's Opening Convocation on Friday, October 17, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. in Coburn Hall. Located in Gloucester, Virginia, the Gloucester Institute honors the legacy of African American leader Dr. Robert Russa Moton by using his historic home, Holly Knoll, for training, conferences and retreats designed to influence the marketplace of social, economic and political ideas in the African American community.

Mrs. James founded the Institute after a 25-year career in the public arena. The United States Senate unanimously confirmed her nomination as Director of the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) on July 11, 2001. As OPM Director, Mrs. James was responsible for more than 3,600 employees across the country and an annual budget in excess of 261 million dollars.

Prior to her work at OPM, Mrs. James served as a Senior Fellow and Director of the Citizenship Project at the Heritage Foundation, Dean of the School of Government at Regent University, and as Chair of the National Gambling Impact Study Commission. Mrs. James also served as Virginia's Secretary of Health and Human Resources.

As a frequent commentator and lecturer, Mrs. James has appeared as a guest on every network morning show, several national news and talk programs, and her editorials have been featured in newspapers across the country.

# Virginia Union Hosts CAPA/MBL Reception

Virginia Union President Dr. Belinda C. Anderson and First Gentleman Eugene Anderson recently hosted the first city-wide networking event for members of the Capital Area Purchasing Association (CAPA) and the Metropolitan Business League (MBL). More than 150 members of CAPA and MBL attended the event held in the Lecture Hall of Virginia Union's L. Douglas Wilder Library and Learning Resource Center.

Governor Tim Kaine has mandated that state agencies in Virginia increase business opportunities for minority and small business owners. "I encourage our members to be mentors to members of the Minority Business League and to help them understand the policies and procedures of doing business with state and local government agencies," said Capital Area Purchasing Association President Jan Giffin.

Metropolitan Business League President Oliver Singleton was grateful for the opportunity to build new working relationships between

public purchasing professionals and small and minority entrepreneurs. "Some business will come from tonight, I guarantee it," Singleton said. "It depends on the energy and persistence of my members. The Capital Area Purchasing Association was chartered in 1976 and has a membership of more than 50 organizations. It is a chapter of

the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing, Inc. and is dedicated to promoting and maintaining purchasing professionalism and proficiency in the field of public sector purchasing and materials management.

The Metropolitan Business League is a not-for-profit business membership organization dedicated to small and minority business development. Founded in 1971, the organization represents nearly 400 small and minority-owned businesses in the Richmond metropolitan area.

## Girls Scouts And Virginia Union Celebrate First African American Troop In South

The three executives joined a large group of young scouts and troop leaders in honoring Girl Scout Troop 101, the first African American troop in a southern city, which held its first meeting on the Virginia Union campus in 1932.

President Anderson noted that Hartshorn Hall's namesake, Hartshorn Memorial College, was the first black women's college in the nation to offer bachelor's degrees. "Just as Hartshorn



Memorial College paved the way for many women to realize their dreams, so has the Girl Scout Commonwealth Council," Anderson said. "The activities you provide to more than 18,000 girls in 30 counties and six cities empower our young women to take an active part in a global sisterhood."

Commonwealth Council CEO Lillie Branch told the group that Virginia's governor had to be petitioned in order to form the first black Girl Scout troop. She contrasted policies then to the organization's current policies. "Today, Girl Scouts of the USA and its local councils and troops value diversity and inclusiveness and do not discriminate or recruit on the basis of race," Branch said.

# Legendary Coach Dave Robbins Retires



After 30 seasons, 713 career victories, and 13 CIAA championships, Virginia Union men's basketball coach Dave Robbins has retired. Robbins made the announcement before a room filled with supporters and media representatives in the L. Douglas Wilder Library Lecture Hall.

"Union won before I got here," said Robbins. "It will continue to win because of the type of young men we bring here." Longtime assistant coach Willard Coker will now step in as head men's basketball coach. "He is more than ready to take the program and run," Robbins said.

During Robbins' last season as head men's basketball coach, the team celebrated his 700th career victory. Robbins is one of only five Division II coaches to reach that milestone. He also led Virginia Union's men's basketball program to Division II national championships in 1980, 1992, and 2005.

Robbins now assumes the position of Senior Administrator for Athletic Development at Virginia Union.

# Greg Richardson Appointed New Head Football Coach

Virginia Union's football program has a new face at the helm this fall. The University announced the appointment of Greg Richardson following the resignation of former head coach Arrington Jones, III. Richardson served as Assistant Head Coach/Defensive



Coordinator during the 2006 and 2007 seasons. He was also a part of Virginia Union's football staff during the 1997 and 1998 seasons. During that time, he led the defense to a #10 ranking in total defense.




