Follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2021 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA. It takes up to three weeks for IRS income information to be available for the IRS Data Retrieval Tool if you electronically filed an IRS tax return, or up to eleven weeks for paper IRS tax return filers.
