It is the policy of the University to present annually a program that focuses solely on academic achievement and honors academic excellence. The Vice President for Academic Affairs has the responsibility for presenting such a program. The Vice President:

- Appoints an ad hoc committee
- Selects a chairperson to direct the planning of the program
- Reviews and approves the program plans
- Serves as ex-officio chairperson

Dean List Qualifications

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student
- Must have a semester GPA of at least a 3.0
- Must not have received any “I,” “NA” or “FA” grades
- Must not have received any grade below a C
