It is the policy of the University that the following grade point designations shall be used when assigning grades:

Each semester hour with a grade “A” is assigned four grade points, “B” three, “C” two, “D” one. Thus, a grade of “B” in a course bearing 3 semester hours credit would be assigned 9 grade points, a “C” in that course, 6 grade points.
